Planning the CICS Transaction Server Migration

An IBM CICS Services specialist works with your technical staff to produce a CICS Transaction Server for z/OS Migration Plan covering the outline project schedule, resources, system and other environmental issues involved with migrating your CICS environment to CICS Transaction Server for z/OS.

Planning the CICS Transaction Server Installation

The IBM CICS Services specialist works with your technical staff to produce an Installation Plan for CICS Transaction Server for z/OS which will include the following:

- Migration of your CICS journals to the MVS logger.
- Changes to the startup, shutdown and recovery operations of your CICS Regions.
- Evaluating your CICS resource definitions to determine if changes are required to migrate macro generated definitions to the CSD.
- Assessing your applications that use the CICS Web Interface provided in CICS MVS/ESA 4.1 to allow these applications to run unchanged using CICS Web Support and the Sockets Domain, within CICS Transaction Server for z/OS.
- Assessing your CICS Transaction Server for OS/390 application features, including shared TS, CF, Data Tables and JCICS.
- Evaluating connectivity between your CICS regions, to enable an equivalent configuration to be built to allow the new CICS regions to connect together in the

CICS Transaction Server for z/OS environment.

- Consideration of your CICS environment use of DB/2 and DL/1 resources.

Installing CICS Transaction Server for z/OS

The IBM CICS Services specialist will install and implement CICS Transaction Server for z/OS according to the Installation Plan.

Basic Skills Instruction

The IBM CICS Services specialist will provide basic skills instruction for up to two of your people on the CICS Transaction Server installation, to help them support, maintain and administer your CICS Transaction Server for z/OS environment.

Participation in project

You designate a representative as the focal point for this project. Your representative:

- Helps resolve project issues and escalates issues within your organization (as necessary).
- Helps resolves any deviations from the project plans.
- Obtains and provides information, data and approvals within three working days of our request, unless an extended response time is agreed upon.
- Provide the IBM CICS Services specialist access to your CICS environment.
